## A Celebrants Guide

*Once you have been chosen to perform a wedding ceremony it is important that you make it a unique and enjoyable celebration. Help create the wedding of their dreams at Wilson Botanic Park Berwick, by following these simple guidelines:*

### Familiar Ground (terms & conditions)

As the celebrant, it is important that you are aware and informed of the Park's terms and conditions, as you need to work within these regulations to contribute to a flawless occasion. Contact Wilson Botanic Park Berwick on (03) 9707 5818 to obtain your copy.

### Right of entry (car park)

Like all wedding guests, celebrant vehicles are required to park in the public car park and walk to the wedding location via the front entrance.

Parking is limited onsite and should be taken into consideration when planning your arrival.

Celebrants will not be permitted vehicle access into the Park under any circumstances.

### Well equipped (set-up)

It is strongly recommended that you visit Wilson Botanic Park Berwick before the wedding day to familiarise yourself with the location, surroundings and distance from the car park.

Consider bringing a trolley for your equipment or you may wish to loan one from the Park's Visitor's Centre between 10am – 4pm daily.

### A moment in time (arrival)

Whilst planning your arrival, keep in mind the amount of time you require to move all your equipment from the car park to the wedding location and the general set up involved. Remember to allow extra time if you need to make more than one trip.

### Step up (footwear)

By bringing two pairs of shoes you can ensure you have appropriate footwear to move all your equipment and preserve your dress shoes for the ceremony.

### Sound effects (PA systems)

Help wedding guests listen to the ceremony by using a loud clear voice or make use of a portable PA system. Bring batteries and make sure you know how to operate it prior to the ceremony.

Power is available at the amphitheatre and the rose garden however this service must be prearranged as additional fees apply.

### Licence to Wed (marriage certificate)

A small wrought table and two iron chairs are provided by the Park for signing of the marriage certificate. Bring a folder or something similar to support the certificate to prevent tearing this important document.
