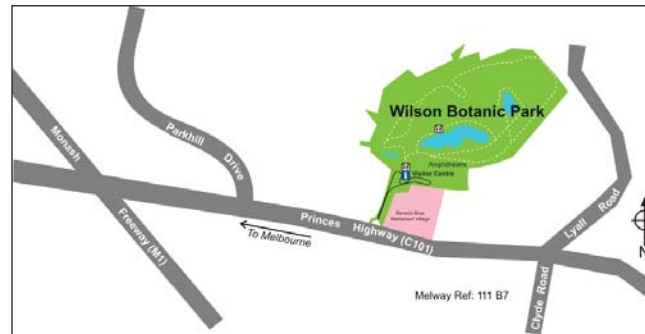
The park is located on Princes Highway, Berwick
