1. Purpose

To outline the proposed future works for the Rutter Park Recreation Reserve Master Plan.

2. Definitions

Council	means Casey City Council, being a body corporate constituted as a municipal Council under the Local Government Act 1989
Councillors	means the individuals holding the office of a member of Casey City Council
Council officer	means the Chief Executive Officer and staff of Council appointed by the Chief Executive Officer.

3. Scope

The master plans relate to the proposed improvement works for the Rutter Park Recreation Reserve. The recommended works will be guided by Council's Leisure Facilities and Development Plan and realised through Council's Capital Works Program.

4. Context

Rutter Park Recreation Reserve is a 14.79ha site which includes:

- one local level cricket oval (also used occasionally for AFL football)
- a tin shed change facility
- one cricket net and picnic facilities
- the eastern half of the site is utilised for a tractor pull event that is held during the summer and attracts large crowds.

5. Plan

The recommended works are as follows and are presented visually in Appendix A.

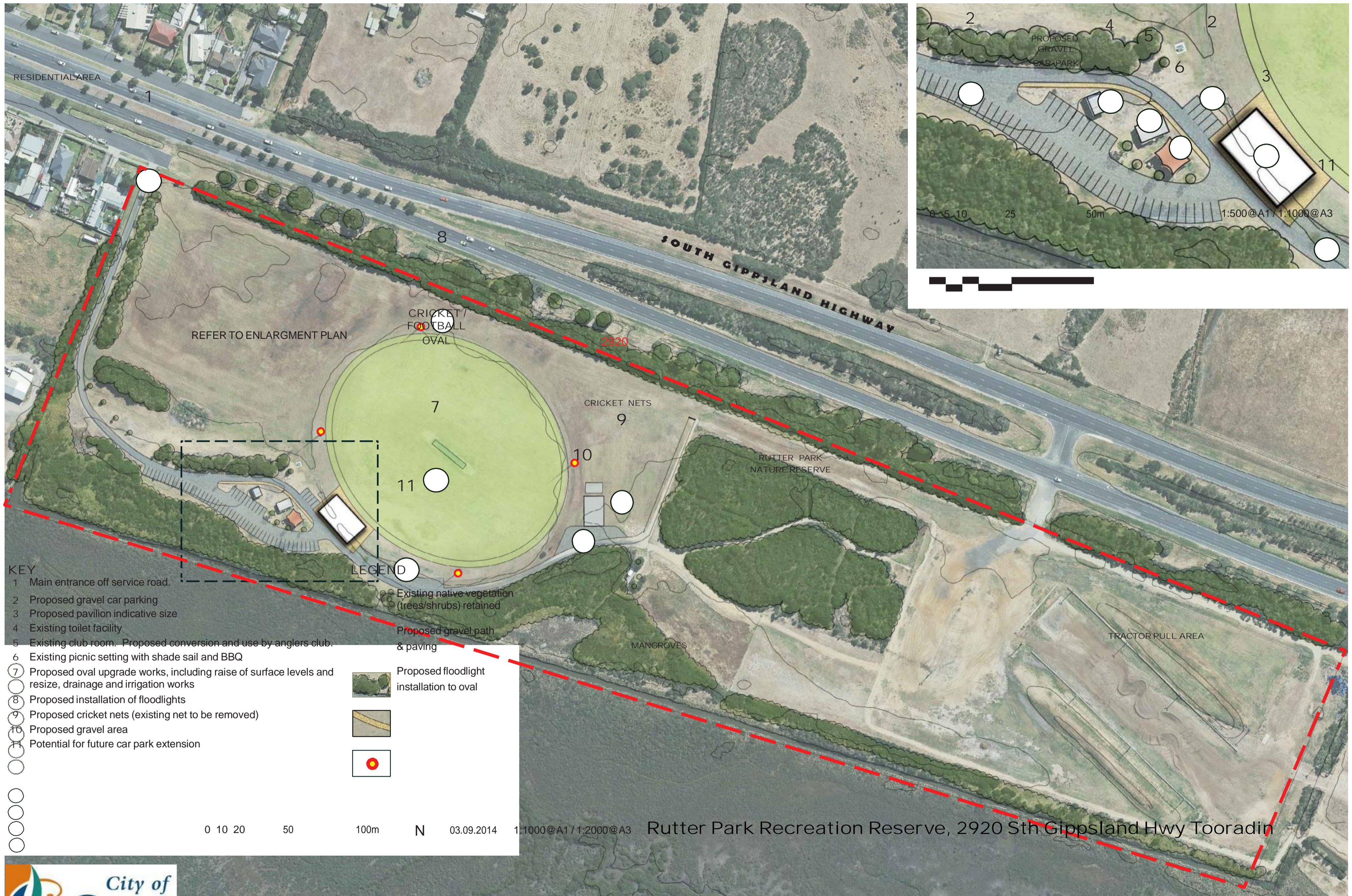
ID	Works	Description
1	Main entrance off service road	For noting only.
2	Proposed gravel car parking for 50 spaces	Proposed formalising of the existing gravel car parking area to provide 50 dedicated spaces. This will improve the capacity of the reserve to accommodate the needs of the sporting groups.
3	Proposed pavilion indicative size	New AFL / cricket sports pavilion proposed to considerably improve the standard and capacity of the venue to accommodate competition and training activities for AFL and cricket.
4	Existing toilet facility	For noting only.
5	Existing club room	For noting only.
6	Existing picnic setting with shade sail and BBQ	For noting only.
7	Proposed oval upgrade including irrigation works	Proposed improvement works including irrigation to the oval to enhance its capacity to accommodate AFL and cricket competition and training activities.
8	Proposed installation of floodlights	Proposed sports floodlighting to enable it to be used for AFL during winter.
9	Proposed cricket nets	Proposed cricket nets to provide improved facilities for cricket.
10	Retain existing cricket net as a throw down net	For noting only.

6. Administrative Updates

It is recognised that, from time to time, circumstances may change leading to the need for minor administrative changes to this document. Where an update does not materially alter this document, such a change may be made administratively. Examples include a change to the name of a Council department, a change to the name of a Federal or State Government department, and a minor update to legislation which does not have a material impact. However, any change or update which materially alters this document must be by resolution of Council.

7. Review

The next biennial review of this document is scheduled for completion by 31 May 2017.
