• inclusive.


Inclusive means everyone in Casey feels like part of the community.

have jobs




go on holidays.

#### **About the City of Casey**

Over 300 thousand people live in Casey.

Over 14 thousand people in Casey have disability.

The number of people with disability in Casey is bigger than in the past.



We know each person with disability in Casey is different.



This framework thinks about ways to help people with different disabilities and needs.



# It is the law for all communities to be accessible


The Disability Discrimination Act is a law that says communities must have accessible

#### **Framework Principles**

The framework has 5 principles.

Principles are like rules.



#### 1 Autonomy

We want people with disability to have power to do things on their own.



#### 2 Opportunity

We want more chances for people with disability to do things they want.



#### 3 Upholding human rights

It is the right of people with disability to live in an accessible community.



#### 4 Embracing diversity

We respect differences in all people in Casey including people with disability.



#### **5** Accountability

We know it is our job to help people with disability in Casey.

# There are 3 goals to help people with disability access Casey

# Goal 1 Create an accessible Casey for people with disability



People with disability told us they would like

• more accessible buildings and services



information and signs that are easy to read.



Better access will help people with disability

feel included



• have more choice and control in their life.

### Goal 2 Promote inclusion and participation for people with disability

Inclusion means everyone feels like part of a place.

Participation means everyone can join in.



People with disability in Casey told us

 they want to do the same things as everyone else in the community



 they do not want to rely on others to do things all the time.

We want the Casey community to be better at including people with disability.



A community that knows more about disability will help people with disability

• they would like the chance to get a job




 they want to have a say in things that matter to them.

• ways to check we do things well.


We will check the plan at different times in the year.
