
Please note:

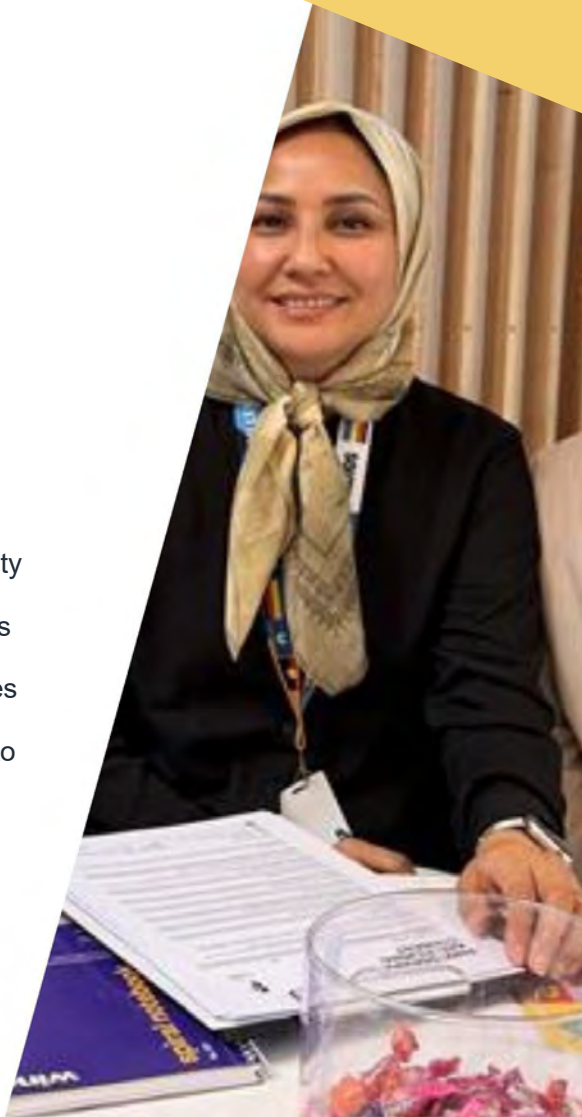
Adaptation Game

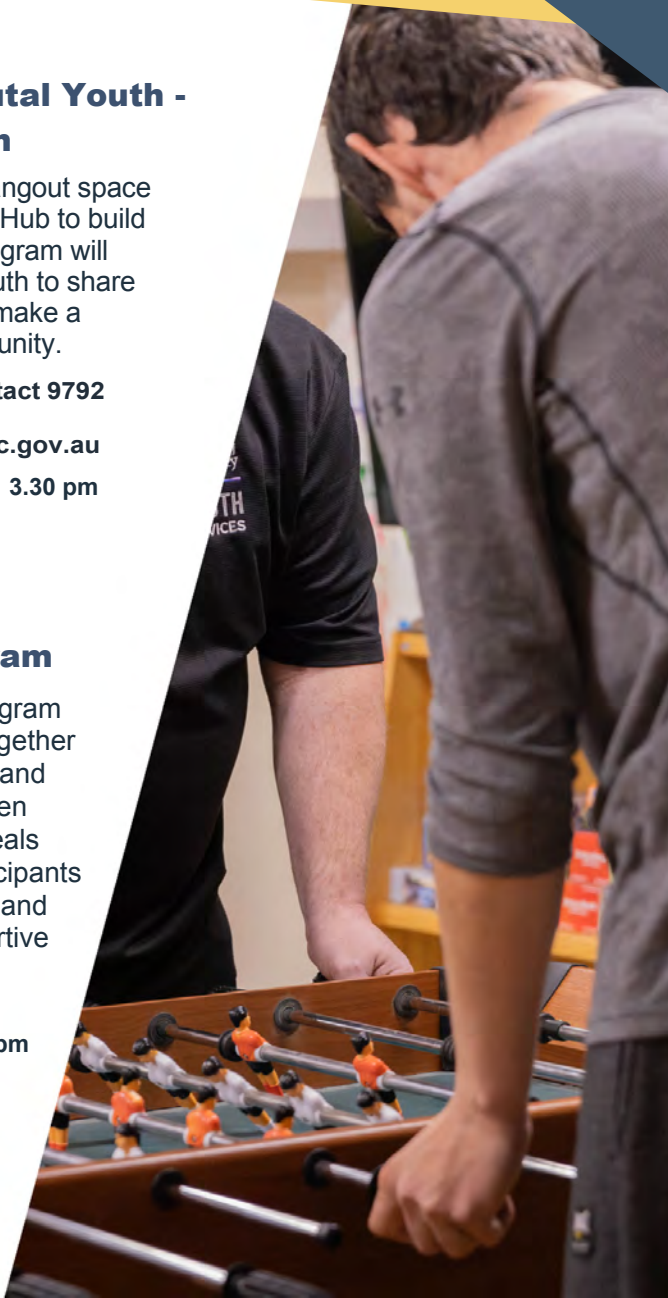
