Helpful Information about the registration stage

How are kindergarten places allocated?

The City of Casey must follow the Department of Education's Priority of Access guidelines when allocating kindergarten places. Each child's registration is given a score based on their family's circumstances. What is the Priority of Access (POA)?

There are two categories of Priority of Access – the Department of Education's Priority of Access and City of Casey's Local Criteria. Each child's registration is given a score based on the information family's provide when completing the registration. This is then used to allocate places. How do I find the kindergarten locations?

You can find all of the kindergarten locations here [Find a kindergarten | City of Casey](#). If you click on 'Find your closest kindergarten' you can enter your residential address and it will show you the closest kindergarten to your house.

I have submitted an expression of interest, do I need to complete the registration?

Yes – you must complete the registration stage to be included in the offer stage.

My child is attending 3 year old kindergarten, do I need to complete a 4 year old application?

Yes – you must submit a new application for 4 year old kindergarten.

I have submitted my registration, how do I find out where my child is on the waiting list?

We don't have a traditional waiting list. When families submit an application, it doesn't automatically place their child in a specific order for a kindergarten place. Instead, all applications are gathered together in a group of children who are awaiting placement. When it comes time to allocate places, all applications in this group are considered for a place at the same time in line with the Priority of Access.

I submitted my application as soon as registration stage opened will my application be prioritised over others submitted later?

Priority is not given to families who have submitted first. All registrations received during the registration stage will be included in the first round of offers regardless of if it is submitted on the first or last date of this stage.
