

DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS REQUIREMENTS



In the City of Casey, you must obtain a permit under the Local Law prior to the discharge of any fireworks on public and private land.

A notice of intention to discharge fireworks must be completed through WorkSafe Victoria for discharging fireworks on both public and private land.

Once you have been approved by WorkSafe Victoria, you must then notify Council and your request will then be assessed.

If you are planning to use fireworks at an event, you must ensure only a licensed pyrotechnician is discharging the fireworks. The pyrotechnician must hold public liability insurance of at least \$20 million dollars.

You must also check with the Country Fire Authority (CFA) about restrictions on the use of fireworks that may apply to your application.

Council will not approve requests for the discharging of fireworks at Casey Fields Cranbourne East. Fireworks are also prohibited within 1km of livestock including horses, cattle, goats and sheep due to animal welfare and unreasonable expectations for owners of livestock to make arrangements for their safe keeping on days when fireworks are discharged.
