Pretend, or imaginative, play develops emotional intelligence - children's skills to recognise, evaluate, express, understand and regulate their feelings and the feelings of others. Emotional intelligence impacts learning, development, including communicating, reading, writing, and making friends. Children can use objects and pretend they are something else. They can distinguish pretend play from real experiences.
