

EXPANDED OUTDOOR DINING

Neighbour Consent Form



To support expanded outdoor dining, City of Casey is offering a temporary exemption to its Footpath Trading Policy. Businesses with a Class 2 or 3 Certificate of Registration under the *Food Act 1984 (Vic)* may be permitted to expand dining onto the footpath in front of an adjoining property to enable increased dining space. Businesses may be permitted to expand to the neighbouring property boundary only, and not beyond.
